Trichomoniasis (trich), a sexually transmitted disease of cows and bulls, causes cows to abort and severely reduces calf crops.

What can I do to keep my herd trich-free?

- **Develop a preventive herd health plan with your**

veterinarian that includes testing, record keeping, and a vaccination schedule.

- Educate yourself and others about the disease. •
- Know the breeding and calving history of your purchases.
